MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT AND PROCEDURES

The Citizen Attention Office (OAC) offers all the information on the municipal administration and the processing of municipal procedures.

REGISTRATION

The first procedure that newcomers have to do is request registration in the municipal register of inhabitants. The registration determines that that person is considered a resident of that community.

What is registration?

Registration is an essential procedure because it gives access to certain rights and because it is an essential requirement to carry out many other procedures and access the rest of the municipal services.

People with nationality from countries that are not members of the European Union without permanent residence authorisation must request the renewal of the registry registration every two years. If it is not renewed, the registration on the municipal register is automatically cancelled because it has expired.

Who can ask for it?

All persons residing in the municipality, regardless of their administrative situation, can be registered.

What documentation must be submitted?

- Personal identification document: DNI, passport, NIE, foreign identity card... In the case of asylum seekers who do not have a passport, they can present the provisional asylum applicant document.
- Original of the family book, in the case of minors. In the case of having the original of the DNI, passport or NIE and accreditation of the person of legal age who holds the legal representation and of the one who carries out the procedure.
- Original documentation accrediting the right to occupy housing.
 Usually, the property deed or current rental contract. If the rental contract is not expressly in force (for example, it has been expressly extended but there is no written documentation that this extension has occurred), the original or bank accreditation of the last rental receipt must also be provided.

ATTENTION AND SUPPORT FOR NEW ARRIVALS

Through the Municipal Immigration Program, information, support and accompaniment are offered to both new arrivals and/or those in an irregular situation and people established in the municipality and/or in a regular situation.

The program includes the following services:

- Arrival Service
- Information and Legal Advice Service on Immigration and International Mobility
- Immigration Reports processing service

Arrival Service

The **Arrival Service** is a set of actions and resources that respond to the initial training and information needs of potential users. It includes accompaniment, training and certification of the minimum knowledge to facilitate life and work in Catalonia.

The training consists of the following modules

MODULE A

Catalan language (90h) Castilian Spanish language (90 h)

MODULE B

Working knowledge (15h)

MODULE C

Knowledge of Catalan society (15h)



Obtaining the Arrival Certificate

The arrival certificate is a document with legal validity and probative value that will be useful in immigration processes (social integration, modification and/or renewal of residence permits) or acquisition of nationality, among others.

HEALTH CARE

Public Health Assistance

In Catalonia, all people, regardless of their legal and registration status, have the right to receive emergency care for illness or serious accident until they are discharged.

The Individual Health Card (TIS) is requested at the Primary Care Centre (CAP). This card identifies and accredits you as a user of the Catalonia public health system. The first is free and facilitates access to the centres in the public health network. It must also be presented at pharmacies in order to obtain medicines financed by the Servei Català de la Salut.

The CAP is the first place to go if there is a health problem or if you want to prevent a disease. It offers health and social assistance, health promotion services, preventive, curative and rehabilitative care. Everyone is assigned a CAP as well as referral medical and nursing professionals.

HEALTH PROMOTION

The Municipal Health Promotion Service carries out actions aimed at promoting individual and collective health. Its main objective is to improve the health of the population by promoting healthy lifestyles, healthy ageing and the promotion of healthy environments. It works especially in the field of education.

Health Promotion has an **Advice service for Drugs and other Risk Behaviours** and offers citizens the possibility of contacting a professional who will assess the consultation made. For:

- General population that wants information about drugs
- Families who need preventive information about drugs, screens and other addictions.
- People and/or families who want to consult about problematic consumption and need advice or information about treatment options.
- Professionals who carry out educational tasks, especially those in contact with young people or adults.

EDUCATION

Attendance at school is compulsory from 6 to 16 years of age regardless of their administrative situation, but, although it is not compulsory, the infant stage begins at 4 months of age. The majority of minors are enrolled in school, at the latest, at 3 years of age.

The educational centres have a Welcome Classroom for newly arrived students. It is a space where they attend part of their schedule in order to acquire the proficiency level of the Catalan language that allows them to follow the rhythm of the ordinary classroom.

The **educational system** is divided into several stages:

- Early Childhood Education, First cycle. From 4 months to 3 years old
- Early Childhood Education, Second cycle. From 3 to 5 years old
- Primary education. From 6 to 12 years old
- Compulsory Secondary Education (ESO). From 12 to 16 years old
- Baccalaureate and professional training cycles. From the age of 16
- Higher level training cycles or university studies. From the age of 18

Cerdanyola has 3 public and 5 private nurseries, 15 infant and primary education centres, 9 secondary education centres, 1 centre that offers intermediate level training cycles, 2 centres where higher level training cycles are offered with the Autonomous University of Barcelona.

Cerdanyola also has 5 special education centres.

The Municipal School Office centralises the pre-registration and admission process for students between 3 and 16 years of age. It is a municipal information, guidance and advice service for schooling in public and subsidised child, primary and secondary education centres.

WORK

In Catalonia, everyone between the ages of 16 and 65 can work. **Non-EU foreigners need a work permit**. For more information on work permits, contact the Information and Legal Advice Service on immigration and international mobility (see p. 8).

Once you obtain the work permit, one of the first steps you must take to search for work is to request registration as a job seeker with the **Occupation Service of Catalonia (SOC-OTG)**.


